ABOUT BACKPACKS 4 VIC KIDS



Backpacks 4 VIC Kids ('B4VK') is an incorporated association, registered as a public benevolent charitable organisation holding Deductible Gift Recipient endorsement.

B4VK operates across a continuum of practice at the governance, management, operational and delivery levels that are reflective of the resources, funding, support, and participation levels from the local community.

Our strength and distinctiveness in the non-profit sector are our agility, product reliability and the combination of formal and informal methods to achieve our mission. B4VK's Headquarters is a welcoming factory, situated in the south-eastern suburbs of Melbourne, Victoria. It is often through informal interaction that needs of local children displaced are identified. Identifying these needs and issues through a range of methods is instrumental in informing the planning and development of activities and programs.

As a community-based and legally constituted organisation, B4VK is governed by a voluntary management commitment, comprising elected members who live, work, or participate in the local community. The Committee of Management is legally accountable to our membership base to endorse the strategic and policy framework of B4VK, ensuring the financial viability of the legal entity, and ensuring compliance with all legislative, statutory and contractual duties, obligations and requirements.

The governance model is developmental, with the governing body working cooperatively and collaboratively with staff, volunteers, clients and the wider community, thus generating a range of community benefits through our community service programs.

Our purpose is to provide material aid to children aged birth to seventeen. It's our passion to ensure that aid is of the best quality and our privilege to support children experiencing crisis, displacement, relocation and homelessness.

ABOUT BACKPACKS 4 VIC KIDS



The CEO is employed by the Committee of Management. The leadership role, while distinct from the governance role, is responsible to (a) advise and inform the governing body, and (b) to manage operations, internal processes, and day-to-day affairs and activities of B4VK.

Operational tasks are undertaken by staff in partnership with volunteers. Members of the governing body are frequently involved in the volunteer effort to complement or support the work of paid staff. The role and contribution of volunteers is significant, producing benefits for all involved.

B4VK plans, develops, and manages the operational structure of the organisation for optimal responsiveness to the complex and diverse needs of our local communities, in accordance with our statement of purpose.

B4VK provides a range of material aid programs for children aged from birth to seventeen, displaced in our local community (mainly Victoria) and from diverse cultural and socio-economic backgrounds. Recipients are children who for a variety of reasons cannot return to their home nor access their belongings. Programs are developed in response to identified community needs, often in consultation with child welfare workers and out-of-home carers, and in line with available resources.

Programs are designed to meet the needs of recipients and prospective recipients. Key strengths of B4VK are our flexibility, agility, resilience, responsiveness and adaptability. Additional impact includes the addressing of social justice issues through awareness-raising, community education and social action.

B4VK is an independent legal entity working collaboratively with social and welfare service providers, like-minded non-profit organisations and individuals providing care in our community. Resources are sought through fundraising, donations, grants, sponsorship and bequests. From time-to-time B4VK subscribes to peak bodies for example Fundraising Institute of Victoria, Our Community, Victorian Council of Social Services. Through membership to these organisations B4VK can work collaboratively on sector based issues and needs. Through membership to these organisations B4VK can access support, resources, information, advice, advocacy, lobbying to government and training.

Thank you for making it possible for us to support over 8,000 children. Your support has directly impacted on the lives of vulnerable children.


We look forward to continuing to engage with ongoing supporters and stakeholders to identify further opportunities to have meaningful and lasting impact and together, making more children smile.

TREASURER'S **REPORT**: HELEN BROWN


Total revenue increased by 54% in 2022 compared to 2021.

Fundraising activities saw an increase of almost 40% on previous year, however the biggest improvement came from Donations which increased 65% against the 2021 year.



Total expenses increased by 22% in 2022 compared to 2021.

Costs associated with delivering Programs and Projects is the main contributor.

EAST VIC DISTRIBUTION CENTRE

In October 2021, we announced the opening of our new East Vic Distribution Centre with the voluntary management of Ian & Keryn McCluskey. The centre, based in Bairnsdale, houses a range of My Essentials (ME) Packs from size 0000 to size 18 to facilitate urgent deliveries in the area.

B4VK currently have involvement with 12 organisations within the Gippsland area. We are proud to have a distribution centre where care workers and care providers have the ability to readily access our ME Packs and other resources that contribute to the safety and wellbeing of children in need.

Located in Bairnsdale, this centre also accepts appropriate donations to fill backpacks on behalf of B4VK.

We welcome Ian & Keryn to our B4VK family and look forward to a long and happy collaboration with them.



SOUTH WEST VIC DISTRIBUTION CENTRE

The number of backpacks distributed by SWVICDC this last financial year was 79. We have a full stock of 76 on hand. For Christmas of 2021, 450 Santa Packs were packed and distributed. Many people and organisations contributed by donating items and money.





As well as liaise with the local agencies to ensure they have ME Packs for their children going into emergency care, we collect donations. Most of these are sent to Cranbourne for packing. We have received a huge number of items for backpacks and Santa Packs, many of which are lovingly handmade (especially blankets). This is as a direct consequence of the relationships we have established with local fundraising / social groups such as Rotary Clubs, Kiwanis, View Club, Presbyterian Church, Freemasons and various Probus Clubs. We have delivered 9 presentations over the year and it has been a matter of course that the groups then become donors.

There are a number of independent 'friends of B4VK' who also donate as well as local businesses such as Ray White Real Estate, Owen Truss, Morton Power, South West Community Foundation, and Warrnambool Bowls Club. Because of the large amount of donations, we have organised to take the donations to Melbourne and have the van pick them up from Fitzroy.

In October 2021, we were fortunate enough to gain the use of 40ft shipping container to stock and pack our Santa Packs. Reg Owen, has very generously given us indefinite free use of the container which is kept cost free on his land in an industrial section of Warrnambool. We are extremely grateful to him for his very kind support.

We would also like to say a special Thanks to Allen's Transport who delivered 200 Santa Packs to Portland and Hamilton for free.

B4VK would like to make a special Thankyou to Jenny & Peter for the fantastic work you do for our organisation.
